Terms and Conditions

Applicants are responsible for selecting a tour appropriate to their abilities and interests. In order to assist you we will be happy to discuss the tours with you as well as provide the names of past participants who can describe their experience of the tour you are considering. Applicants are held responsible for being in sufficiently good health to undertake the tour, and are responsible for preparing for the tour by studying the itinerary and pre-departure information sent to them by South African Roadrunners and for bringing appropriate clothing and equipment as advised therein. South African Roadrunners operate tours in parts of the world where political instability is not uncommon, and in back country areas subject to extreme weather conditions and other natural forces. Tour members are ultimately responsible for determining whether it is appropriate for them to travel to a particular destination, or to participate in any particular activity.

Reservation

To reserve a place on a tour, submit this application with a reservation deposit of £ 300. You will be sent confirmation and more information about the tour. An invoice for the tour balance will be sent to you for payment no later than 60 days prior to departure.

Covered Expenses

The tour cost is based on accommodations on a shared occupancy basis. Single occupancy room arrangements are usually available for a supplemental cost. Whilst we will do our best to find a suitable roommate, this is not always possible in which case you will be allocated a single room and charged a single supplement. We reserve the right to raise the tour cost if there are exceptional cost increases beyond our control. The tour cost includes all accommodations, all meals (except on rest days), all planned entrance fees as detailed in the itinerary, the services of guides, drivers, mechanics, planned airport transfers, petrol, use of motorcycle, spare parts and support vehicle.

Not Included are : Airfares to and from George, South Africa, passports, visas, immunisations, medical insurance and medical costs, evacuation costs from remote areas, alcoholic beverages, laundry, excess baggage charges, motorcycle accident damage repair costs, tips to guides and staff and any expenses of whatever nature arising from the delay or extension of a trip due to weather, political disputes, strike action, illness, failure of transportation or other causes beyond our reasonable control.

Medical and Health

It is imperative that persons with medical problems make them known to us well before departure. The tour leader has the right to disqualify anyone at any time during the trip if he / she feels the tour member is incapable of safely completing the tour, or if a members participation might jeopardise the safety of another individual or that of the group. Refunds will not be given under such circumstances.

Insurance

Due to the strenuous nature of some of our tours and the remoteness of some destinations, insurance is highly recommended. Whilst South African Roadrunners will attempt to secure the services of a doctor in the case of an emergency, we cannot guarantee the same, and accept no liability regarding provision of medical care. We insist that each tour participant takes out travel insurance upon booking of the holiday to cover themselves in the case of trip cancellation and medical care and possible evacuation if required.

Cancellation and Refunds

If you cancel your reservation, your deposit will be forfeited and the balance of your payment returned less a cancellation fee as follows. (Computed as of the date of our receipt of your written cancellation notice). More than 60 days - £ 300., 31 - 60 days - 50% of land tour cost, 16 - 30 days - 75 % of land tour cost. Less than 16 days - 100% of land tour cost. Airline ticket refunds are the responsibility of the tour participant, so please ensure purchase of adequate tour cancellation insurance at the time of tour balance invoice payment and / or air ticket purchase.

South African Roadrunners reserves the right to cancel any tour upto two weeks prior to tour start date for any reason whatsoever, including insufficient sign-up or logistical problems which will impede tour operation. In this case, the applicant will be notified forthwith, and payment of the land tour cost refunded in full which will constitute full and final settlement.

South African Roadrunners are not to be held responsible for nonrecoverable expenses incurred by tour participants in preparing for a tour which is cancelled. These expenses might include but are not limited to; non refundable advance purchase airtickets, visa fees, equipment, insurance etc., nor for any additional arrangements should the participant have embarked prior to the tour start date. In the event a tour cannot be started or must be interrupted or ended for reasons outside the control of South African Roadrunners, its agents, outfitters or contractors as in the case of but not limited to : civil unrest, riots, strikes, government restrictions, earthquake, floods or other forces of nature, this contract will become invalid.

South African Roadrunners reserves the right to accept, decline or retain any tour participant from any tour at any time and to cancel any contract on grounds of a tour member not complying with local laws or South African Roadrunners requirements for group travel. Participants agree to accept the authority and rules of South African Roadrunners, its guides, outfitters and contractors.

Motorcycle Damage Deposit

A safety damage deposit of £ 300 (Pounds Sterling three hundred or equivalent) is required prior to tour departure, and will be refunded to the participant upon return to the Company of an undamaged motorcycle. Whilst South African Roadrunners will make every effort to supply a back-up motorcycle and / or spares in the case of a mechanical breakdown, the Company is not obliged to replace a damaged motorcycle.

Assumption of all Risks and Release of Liability

I hereby acknowledge that during my participation on this tour arranged by South African Roadrunners, their agents, outfitters and contractors, there are risks and dangers that may arise including but not limited to: dangers of traveling in mountainous terrain, high altitude, forces of nature, civil unrest, terrorism, travel by aircraft, truck, bus, jeep, car, motorcycle, rickshaw, watercraft, elephant or other means of transportation, accident or illness in remote areas without means for rapid evacuation or availability of medical supplies and facilities. I hereby release South African Roadrunners, their agents, guides, outfitters and contractors from any and all liability arising from my death, illness, injury, emotional trauma, delay, loss or damage to personal property, negligence or recklessness of any kind, and from all claims, demands or expenses resulting from my participation on the tour. I acknowledge that the enjoyment and excitement of adventure travel and particularly motorcycle touring is derived in part from the inherent risks incurred by travel and activity beyond the accepted safety of life at home, work or in my home country and that these inherent risks contribute to such enjoyment and excitement, and being a reason for my participation on the tour.

The above Assumption of All Risks and Release of Liability provisions apply to all members of my family, including any minors accompanying me, and are binding upon myself, my heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

I have carefully read and agree to all the conditions as stated under "Terms and Conditions", especially noting the policy of "Reservations" and "Cancellation and Refunds". I have also read the above paragraphs entitled "Assumption of All Risks" and "Release of Liability" and I confirm my unconditional acceptance to the terms of this contract which I herewith enter into by signing hereunder:
